OUR CHURCH IN ACTION

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS:

Session met on February 19th in Fellowship Hall. Here are some of the highlights under discussion.

WORSHIP: Look for a new order of worship starting March 1st. Children's Chat will be AFTER the reading of the Scripture and Joys and Concerns will be AFTER the Sermon. This is following the service order held in most of the Presbyterian churches and follows a better attuned worship flow.

MISSION: Ministerial Assoc met with an Elderbridge spokesperson to see if we could participate in a meals program for our seniors and those that are homebound. There is a lot of fact finding to be done to see if this is viable in our community and we are still researching the parameters. Will keep you posted if this is something we can do as a community.

CHRISTIAN GROWTH: We have finalized the date for Senior Recognition Sunday to April 5th. We had some date changes due to availability of all three of our seniors but the date is set. There will be a Pot Luck after service to meet with family and friends of our three graduating seniors, Daniel Langner, Beth Bailey, and Jordan Grothe.
